TO: Individuals Responsible for Preparing the FFIEC 030 Report

Effective as of the September 30, 2016, report date, reporting institutions have the option to file the Foreign Branch Report of Condition (FFIEC 030) electronically or in paper form.

Reporting institutions that wish to submit their FFIEC 030 reports electronically using the Federal Reserve's Reporting Central application should contact their Reporting and Reserves District Contact (<https://www.frbervices.org/contacts/index.jsp>) for instructions. For institutions that do not choose to file the FFIEC 030 report electronically, the Federal Reserve will continue to accept paper copy submissions of the report. An electronic filing option is not currently available for the Abbreviated Foreign Branch Report of Condition (FFIEC 030S).
