

## What's New: National Information Center (NIC) Initial Release of February 2006

Below is a summary of the changes to the NIC Web Site by module.

### Institution Search

- Separate Basic and Advanced Searches to further customize searches
- Added the search by RSSD ID, FDIC Certificate Number, or Routing Transit Number (ABA Number) on the Advanced Institution Search
- Ability to search for exclusively Non-Current institutions, as well as Current institutions and both Current and Non-Current institutions
- Included more institution types on the Advanced Search to further define searches. These include Cooperative Banks, Industrial Banks, and Financial Holding Companies

### Institution Results

- The RSSD ID is posted next to each institution in parenthesis for easier referencing
- Only 20 institutions will appear on the page to improve overall performance

### Institution Profile

- Includes links to all structure data, such as the Organization Hierarchy, Branch Locator, and Institution History, and provides characteristic and financial information

### Financial Data

- Financial statements are only available for bank holding companies filing the FR Y-9C, FR Y-9LP, FR Y-9SP or U.S Branches and Agencies filing the FFIEC 002 report
- Users looking for different financial reports will be provided a link to the FDIC or the NCUA Web site

### Organization Hierarchy

- Reports can be generated in PDF format or HTML format depending on the size of the report
- Reports of HMDA Respondents can be created for select institutions

### Branch Locator

- Reports can be generated in PDF format or HTML format depending on the size of the report
- Users can search for domestic and foreign branches of financial institutions on the same search screen

### Institution History and Institutions Bought By X

- Together, they replace the "What Happened in an Institution?" and "Who has an Institution Acquired?" searches

### Other Screens and Features

- Help pages to guide users throughout the search and selection screens
- New and improved Institution Type glossary and Banking Terms glossary
