TO: The Individual Responsible for Preparing FFIEC 030S Foreign Branch Reports of Condition

Effective as of the December 31, 2017, report date, reporting institutions have the option to file the Foreign Branch Report of Condition (FFIEC 030S) electronically or in paper form.

Reporting institutions that wish to submit their FFIEC 030S reports electronically using the Federal Reserve's Reporting Central application should contact their Reporting and Reserves District Contact (<https://www.frbervices.org/contacts/index.jsp>) for instructions. For institutions that do not choose to file the FFIEC 030S report electronically, the Federal Reserve will continue to accept paper copy submissions of the report.
